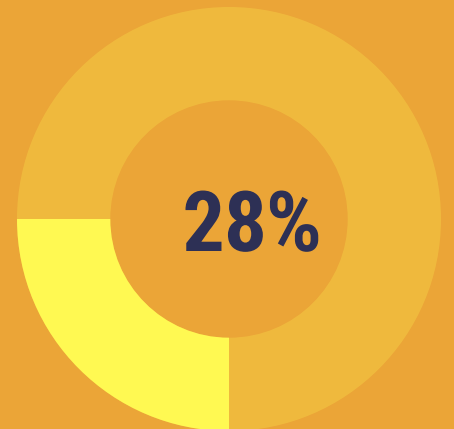
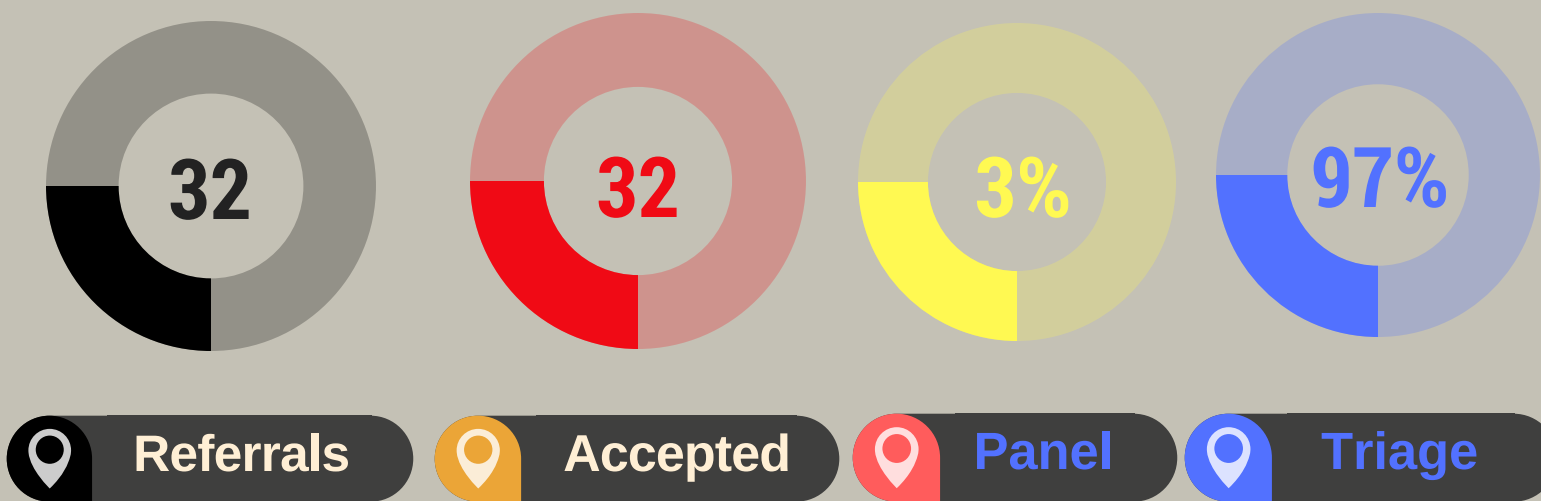

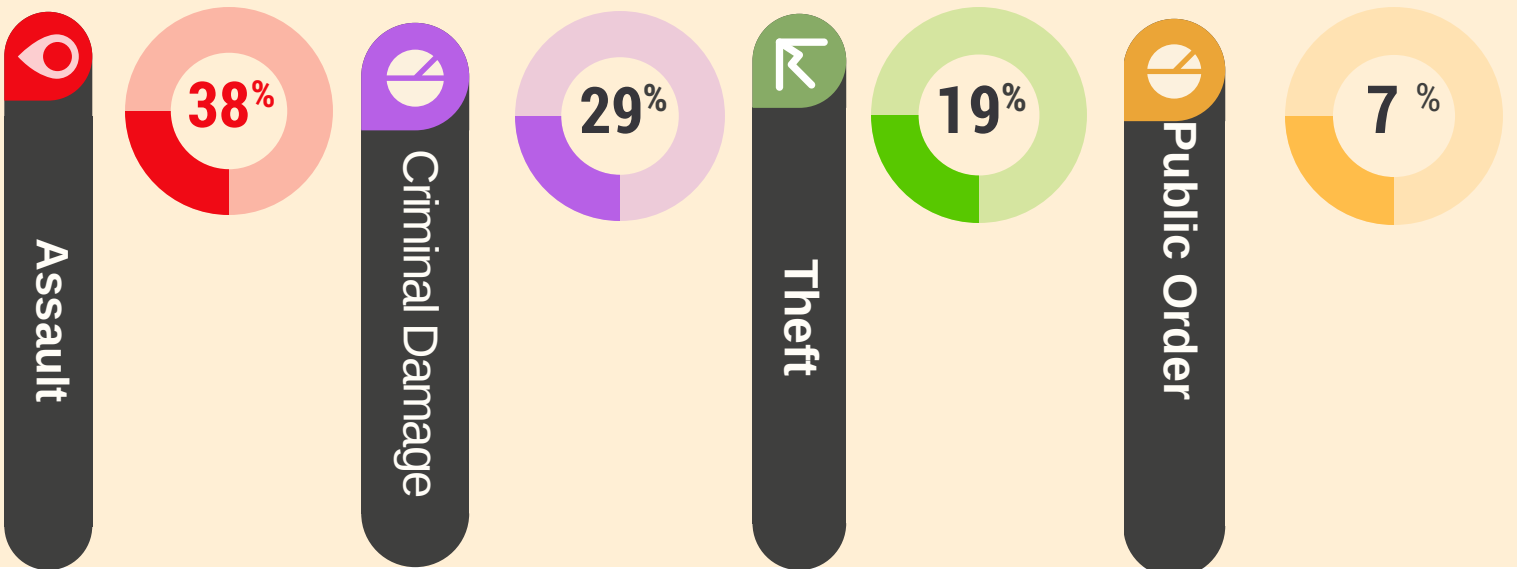
APRIL 1ST 2017 - JUNE 30TH 2017

The majority of referrals received between April 1st 2017 and June 30th 2017 came from South Yorkshire Police



72% of all referrals received were Young Men with Young Women accounting for 28%

In terms of total offences attributed to each offence category **assault** ranks the highest in this period.

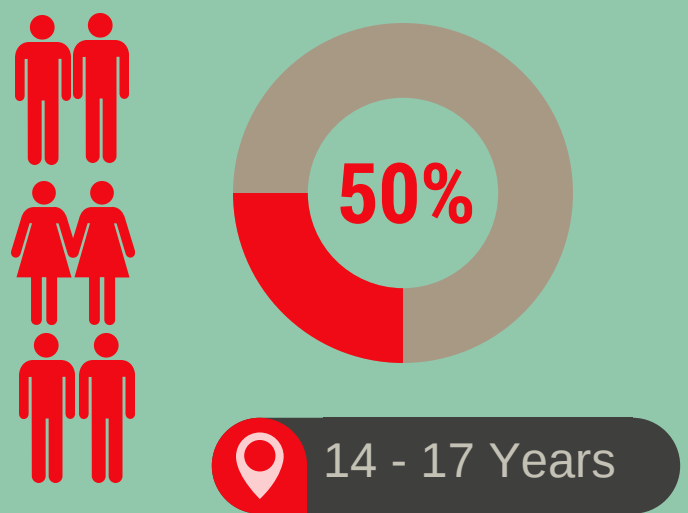
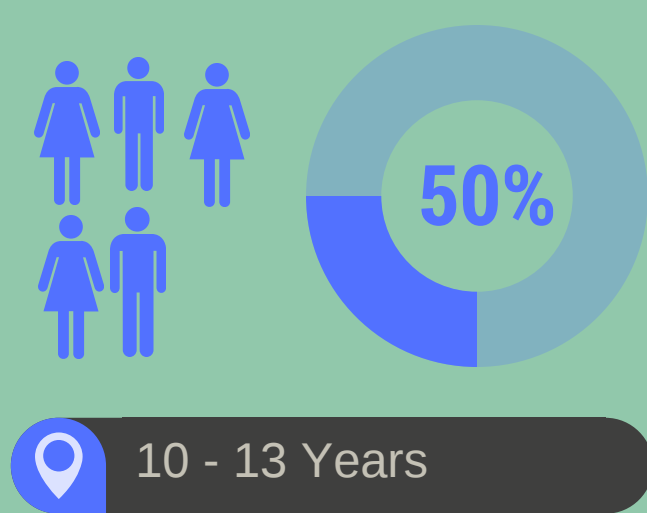


38% of referrals during Q1 live within the Central Neighbourhood of Doncaster, with 25% living in the East and North and 13% living in the South.



Case and Key Workers have carried out 216 One - One Session with Young People.

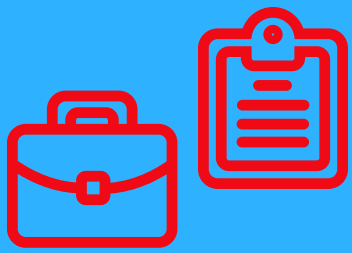
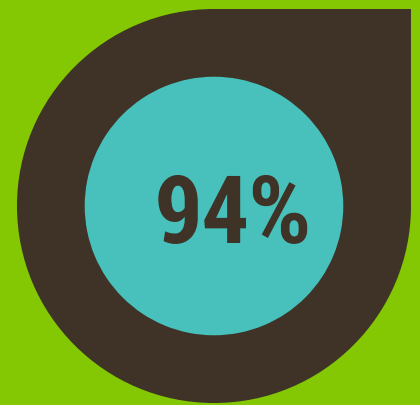
Referrals Received



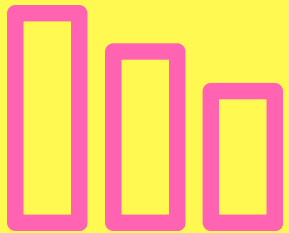
Of the referrals received this period both age group accounted for a 50% share.

Ethnicity

Of the 32 open cases a total of 32 Young People disclosed their ethnicity, describing themselves as White British making up just over 94% of all open cases



Case and Key Workers have attended over 16 CIN/CP/TAC and Professional Meetings along with 138 Home Visits



The number of Youth Cautions across Doncaster during this quarter (Q1 2017) has reduced by 64% compared with the same period in 2016



Team Around the Street : Conisbrough

The Team Around the Street and Positive Activities Projects have engaged with over **400** Young People in a range of Positive Activities and Conversation.



Cost Avoidance (CA)



The cost of one Young Person entering the Criminal Justice System is **£3,620**.

During Quarter One EPIC have engaged with and offered a diversionary programme to 32 Young People which equates to a cost avoidance of **£115,840**
